- Floristry (vocational training certificate)
- Hospitality / Catering (vocational training certificate, BTEC National Diploma & Higher National Diploma by apprenticeship)
- Garden Machinery mechanics (vocational training certificate & BTEC National Diploma)
- Car Maintenance (BTEC National Diploma)

















Under the authority of three ministries (National Education, Agriculture and Food, and the Ministry of the Sea), Olivier GUICHARD vocational school is the only school in France to combine a productive agricultural operation with a hotel and restaurant section.
